
Georgia Urology's Cumming ASC accepting all lithotripsy patients

FROM THE GWINNETT AREA, take Sugarloaf Pkwy, Peachtree Industrial Blvd, McGinnis Ferry Rd and Old Atlanta Rd to Deputy Bill Cantrell Memorial Road.

FROM THE NORTHWEST, take I-75 S from North Marietta Pkwy NE, follow I-75 S, I-285 E and GA-400 N/US-19 N to Forsyth County, take the GA-20 E exit from GA-400 N/US-19 N, then follow Ronald Reagan Blvd to Deputy Bill Cantrell Memorial Road.

FROM SOUTH OF THE CITY, I-85 N, GA-400 N and US-19 N to Forsyth County, Take the GA-20 E exit from US-19 N, then follow Ronald Reagan Blvd to Deputy Bill Cantrell Memorial Road.

FROM EAST OF THE CITY, take I-285 N and GA-400 N/US-19 N to GA-141 N in Forsyth County. Take exit 13 from GA-400 N/US-19 N.

FROM OF WEST OF THE CITY, take I-285 N and GA-400 N/US-19 N to Forsyth County, then take the GA-20 E exit from GA-400 N/US-19 N.
